

Guidelines for Church Members attending Services

Before Attending a Service

- Please ensure you have read and understood these **Guidelines for Church Members attending Services**.
- Do **not** attend a service if you have any of the symptoms of Covid 19; high temperature, new persistent cough, loss of taste/smell.
- Please ensure you bring everything you will need with you. We are unable to provide any shared resources at the moment.
- Please note that all windows and doors will be open to increase ventilation during the services. Dress appropriately to ensure you remain warm during a Scottish summer!

Entering the Building

- Please follow the signage and markings and stay 1 metre apart from other households.
- You must sanitise or wash your hands upon entry to the church.
- Please ensure that you wear a face mask or covering. This is mandatory unless you are exempt (please advise an Elder if this is the case – discretion assured).
- Please complete the “Check In Scotland” register to ensure we have the details of your attendance registered.
- Please find an appropriate seat within the main hall. Rows are spaced 1m apart and within a row you should leave 2 seats (1m) space between households.



During the Service

- Please stay in your allocated seat and keep movement around the hall to a minimum.
- Please keep your face mask/covering on at all times, unless participating in the service.
- You may sing along with hymns and songs but should leave your face mask on as you do.

Worship

- You may remove your mask to participate in prayer during the worship service.
- The bread and wine will be distributed differently during the service. A deacon will take round the tray with the bread and wine on it. Please take an individual piece of bread and an individual cup of wine without touching the tray. You should dispose of your own cup as you leave the building.
- We will take an uplift collection, again a deacon will circulate with the bag, please indicate to the deacon if you wish to contribute in this way.

Between Worship and Family Services

- We are still unable to serve tea/coffee within the building at the moment.
- During the break between services you may “bring your own” for the time being. Please note there will be no access to kitchen, crockery, cutlery, kettles or microwave.
- You are asked to remain in your seats during the break, limiting movement around the building.

Leaving the Building

- Please follow the signage and markings and stay 1 metre apart from other households.
- Exit the main hall via the fire exits directly into the car park.
- Sanitise your hands upon leaving the hall.
- Please take all belongings and other items, eg. Rubbish, with you upon exit.
