- B) A delegation arrived to locate a suitable site at Nyangombe for a Zamtel cellphone communication tower. The lead man told us that the President had insisted that a tower be located at Nyangombe and we sincerely thank the Lord for this development as it has been a matter of prayer for the last year.
- C) We have been enabled, through a gift from Ebe Trustees, to purchase 1,000 Roofing sheets to assist poorer assemblies roof their newly built, permanent structures and to place an order for 1,000 Bibles in Lunda to get God's Word into the hands of local people.

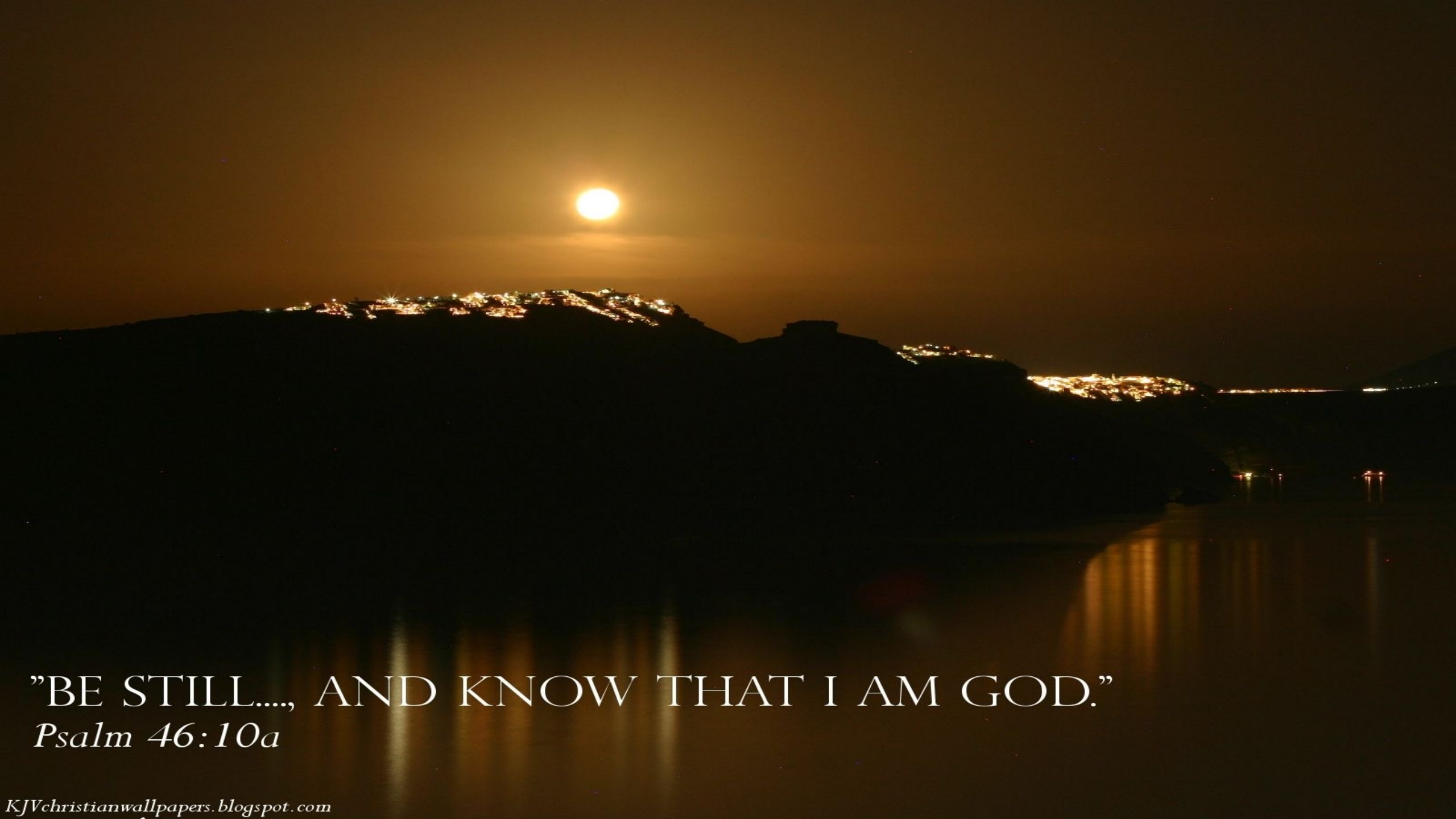

- Pray for the outreach with the kid's ministry we will have at the end of June, where a GLO team will join us for that. We are aiming to reach out to 70 kids for a day camp during the last week of June.
- On the second week of July, we are taking 70 young people to a summer camp. Only 10 of those are Christian, and the rest will hear the gospel for the first time.
- On the third week of July, we will have the second camp for the pre-teenagers. We are going to have 80 pre-teens to a full week of gospel centred camp. Again, only 15 of those are Christians and the rest will hear the gospel for the first time.
- During August, we will do mostly follow up with the new people that we will meet in these camps.
