



From October 14th to 18th, Marie and Phil are going to Entrepierre for a personal retreat supervised by professionals, to reflect on the year to come. One of the goals is to consider new projects. We need guidance from above.

On October 20, Phil and a small group are organizing a joint worship service in the area, which will bring together about 600 Christians from our churches.
